

SARANGI APPOINTED SECI CMD LEADERSHIP SHIFT TO BOOST SOLAR PUSH

Senior IAS officer Santosh Kumar Sarangi has been appointed as the new Chairman and Managing Director (CMD) of the Solar Energy Corporation of India (SECI), while concurrently serving as Secretary of the Ministry of New & Renewable Energy. Sarangi brings to SECI a strong background in policy-making and administration, having previously held the post of Director General of Foreign Trade. His appointment follows the sudden removal of the previous CMD, Rameshwar Prasad Gupta. With SECI playing a central role in India's solar mission, Sarangi's leadership is expected to drive faster implementation of large-scale solar projects and policy innovation in the renewable energy domain.



SOLAR SURGE: INDIA ADDS 10 GW IN JUST 4 MONTHS



In a landmark achievement for the country's renewable energy ambitions, India added over 10 GW of solar capacity between January and April 2025 — the highest quarterly addition recorded in the past five years. This historic growth brings the nation's cumulative solar capacity to an impressive 108 GW. The surge is attributed to favorable policies, declining technology costs, and heightened investor interest ahead of the June 2025 phase-out of the 100% ISTS charge exemption. The broader renewable sector also saw a significant boost, with total additions (including wind) hitting over 13 GW, reaffirming India's steadfast progress toward its 500 GW target by 2030.
