NOW THE WORLD'S 3RD LARGEST WIND & SOLAR POWER GENERATOR



India has achieved a significant milestone by surpassing Germany to become the third-largest generator of wind and solar power globally, now positioned just behind China and the United States. This remarkable achievement highlights the nation's rapid strides in renewable energy deployment and its unwavering commitment to building a sustainable energy future.

As of October 2024, India's installed renewable energy capacity has reached an impressive 203.18 GW, accounting for 46.3% of the country's total energy capacity. A major contributor to this growth is the solar sector, with 92.12 GW of solar energy projects already operational and more in various stages of implementation and bidding.

In addition to solar, India also boasts a robust wind energy manufacturing ecosystem. The country is home to 20 manufacturers producing 53 different wind turbine models, some of which are being exported to international markets, including Europe and the United States — a clear indicator of India's rising influence in the global renewable sector.

As India continues to expand its renewable capacity, there's an ever-growing need for innovative solutions, high-efficiency systems, and reliable energy technologies. POWERING THE FUTURE:

BATTERY ENERGY STORAGE SYSTEMS IN INDIA'S RENEWABLE REVOLUTION



As India accelerates its renewable energy journey, efficient storage is becoming vital. Solar and wind, by nature, are intermittent—making Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS) essential to ensure energy availability when needed most.

To meet the ambitious target of 500 GW of renewable energy by 2030, BESS helps stabilize the grid by storing excess energy for use during peak demand. Encouragingly, BESS costs have seen a sharp decline—from ₹10,80,000/MW/month in 2022 to ₹2,21,000 in recent tenders—driven by falling lithium-ion battery prices.

With India projected to need 74 GW of storage by 2032, BESS will play a critical role in building a clean, reliable, and resilient power future.
